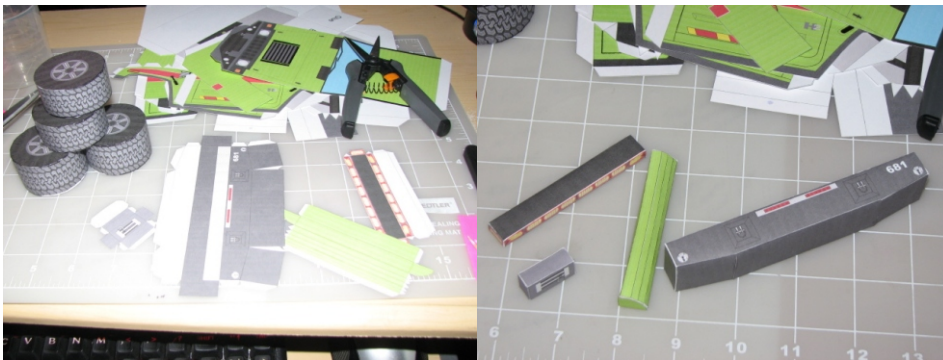


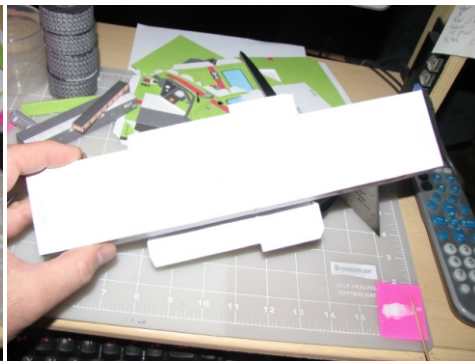
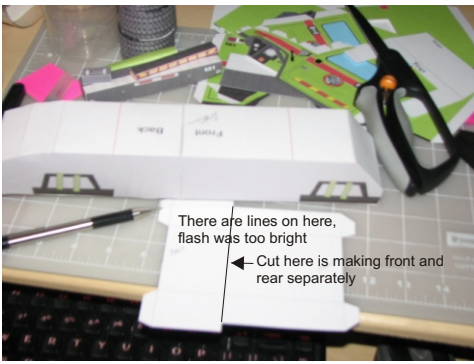
Start by scoring, then cutting out all the parts, It's easier to clip 2 tire treads together and cut out the tabs, saves some time, glue the treads together



Start on the smaller parts and glue them together



Start on the front and back supports, glue them together, at this point you can leave them separate and assemble the front and rear separately and then glue them together as opposed to doing it like I have



Glue the bottom part to the support, pay attention to the guide lines



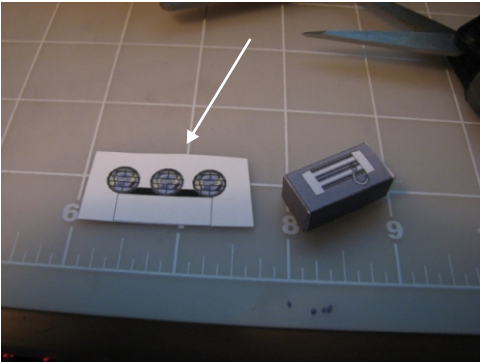
Time to make the front half, once its glue together, you can attach it to the main support



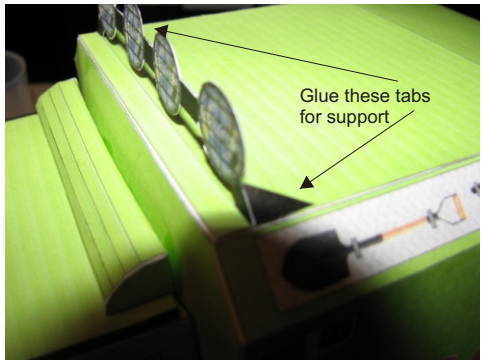
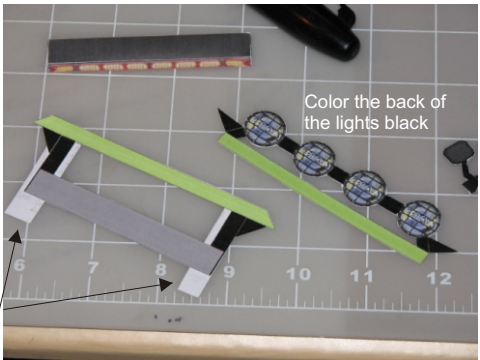
Start the rear half, once assembled, glue the small part to the rear



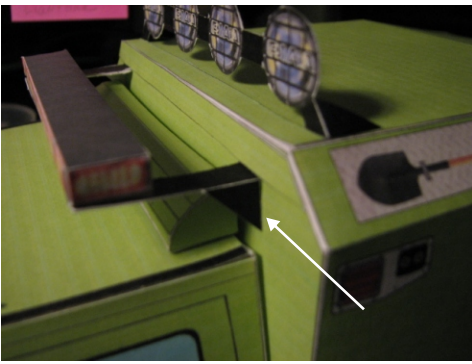
Time to glue the rear half to the main support and to the front half, now you can start adding the small parts and the tires, pay attention to the glue areas on the tires so the model sits level



Color the back of the piece black, cut out and glue, then glue to front bumper area



Time to work on the flood lights and light bar mount, glue 2 extra pieces of card stock to this area for strength, lights mounted, notice green strip glued and small corner tabs glue for support



Light bar mounted, green piece glued, black tabs glue for support



Cut a small slit in the black area for mounting
Mirror, this makes it more secure than just glueing to the outside.



Finished model !!!!! Now Iron Hide, Bumble Bee and Optimus Prime have a little more help.

Note: you may need to glue a layer of cardstock to the inside of the hood area so that it stays level and doesn't pop down.

I tried to make this as accurate to the movie version as I could. Feel free to make improvements and let me know what you did.
