









McDonnell F-4J Phantom F-4J BuNo 155800 / NG 100 flown by L1 Randy 'Duke' Cunningham and L1(jg) Willie Driscoll, VF-96, embarked aboard USS Constellation, May 1972 Randy 'Duke' Cunningham joined the US Navy in 1966 and went to Vietnam with VF96, flying the McDonnell Douglas F-4, hantom. He became the conflict's first fighter Ace and was to become one of the most highly decorated Aces of the war. With his R10, Willie Driscoll, Duke achieved five victories in Vietnam, including 'three-in-e-dey' on 10th May 1972 while flying F-4J BuNo 155800. Willie Driscoll joined the Navy in 1969 and flew his first combat missions in Newment 1971. It were not to complete the Phantom including 452 carrier deck landings. Flying with Cunningham on 10th May 1972, they shot down three MiGs, but were themselves shot down by a North Vietnamese SAM the same day.
